

Submitting Data with your Discussion Paper

If you would like to submit data files associated with your paper you can submit them via the CEP Discussion Paper Submissions Process.

The data will ONLY be accepted if it is submitted in the following format:

All data, instructions, programmes and documentation must be saved into a single zipped file. There should also be a text or PDF file called README.TXT or README.PDF which describes all the files and contents.

Use Winzip – the standard compression programme available on CEP and LSE computers.

Users outside of the School can either download winzip from <http://www.winzip.com/> or should contact their own institution IT support.

Included in the Zipped file should be a README file either in PDF or Text Format explaining each of the components in the zipped file.

The Zipped file MUST NOT contain the discussion paper.
