*This is a guide to help you prepare papers in a uniform style for electronic publication in the CEP Discussion Paper series. Please make sure that you read carefully the following information:*

### **Authors' Guidelines for Discussion Papers**

1. Papers should ideally have been previously given at a conference, seminar or workshop, not necessarily at CEP. The system automatically directs your paper to your programme director who will approve it or recommend edits.
2. We will ONLY accept the main paper in Adobe PDF format. Instructions on how to create PDF documents and the CEP style guide are available at <http://cep.lse.ac.uk/pubs/submissions/>
3. Complete the online submissions form at <http://cep.lse.ac.uk/pubs/submissions/> . Submit the following details: \*title, \*author(s), author affiliations and contact information, \*abstract, \*JEL classification numbers, \*keywords, \*data used and acknowledgements. Starred \* fields are mandatory.

We will NOT accept discussion papers without these details. You will then be prompted to email the PDF paper to the appropriate programme director and the CEP publications administrator, currently (Oct 06) Jo Cantlay, standing in for Helen Durrant.

- Programme Directors will make every possible effort to respond to papers submitted within one week. Unless revisions are required, your work – on approval – will be sent directly to the publications administrator who will then upload your paper CEP website.
- We will also be forwarding your discussion paper to our journalist, Romesh Vaitilingam for a possible article in CentrePiece (if you agree).
- We will send your paper to the SSRN (Social Sciences Research Network) – the electronic network that disseminates information about research in the social sciences to subscribers around the world ([www.ssrn.com](http://www.ssrn.com)) and to RePEc (Research Papers in Economics) a similar resource for dissemination ([www.repec.org](http://www.repec.org)).
